WHEREAS, the communication center is the backbone of any public safety organization's ability to provide emergency services to their community and the public safety communication center plays a vital role during critical incidents; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coronado maintains a Public Safety Communication Center which serves as the first point of contact between community members and emergency services and does so in an effective and professional manner; and

WHEREAS, in 2024, our Dispatch Center personnel answered 8,068 9-1-1 calls, 35,956 administrative calls, 534 text-to-911 calls, and processed 47,591 incidents; and

WHEREAS, when an emergency occurs, the prompt response of public safety personnel is critical to the protection of life, property, and security; and

WHEREAS, our dispatchers are the first responders who receive and transmit critical information from our residents, visitors, business community, and outside agencies as emergencies occur; and

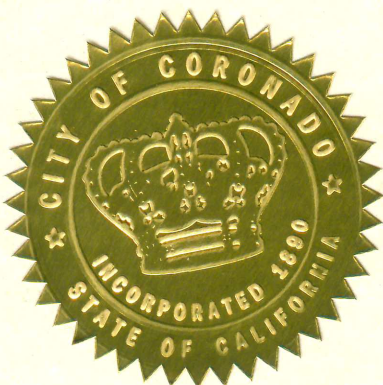
WHEREAS, the safety of our police officers, firefighters, and community depends on the information obtained by our dispatch staff from those who contact the Coronado Police Department Communication Center.


