WHEREAS, during Arts Education Week, we celebrate the invaluable contributions of arts educators and their positive impact on our students, schools, and community.



"ARTS EDUCATION WEEK"


in the City of Coronado and encourage all residents to join in recognizing the importance of arts education and honoring our arts educators for their dedication, creativity, and service to our community.
