

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-44

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONADO, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT AND APPROPRIATION OF FISCAL YEAR 2022-23 RIDE TO LIVE MOTORCYCLE EDUCATION GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY (OTS) IN THE AMOUNT OF \$65,000”

WHEREAS, The Office of Traffic Safety provides grant funds to local Police Departments to support their equipment and program needs with the primary goal of providing free public motorcycle training to aid in reducing injuries and deaths due to motorcycle collisions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coronado Police Department is eligible to receive a portion of these grant funds provided by the State of California through the Office of Traffic Safety and the City Council is authorized to approve and accept the receipt of grant funds, when the funds are made available; and

WHEREAS, through the Office of Traffic Safety, Coronado has been approved to receive grants funds to purchase training supplies, rent sites, and overtime costs to enable the City’s Ride to Live motorcycle education program to operate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Coronado as follows:

1. That the above recitations are true.
2. That the City Council approves and authorizes the receipt and appropriation of \$65,000 in grant funds provided by the State of California Office of Traffic Safety (OTS).
