

ORDINANCE NO. 2022-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONADO, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING PARAGRAPH C OF SECTION 2.46.020 OF THE CORONADO MUNICIPAL CODE REGARDING DESIGN REVIEW COMMISSION MEMBERSHIP

WHEREAS, paragraph C of Section 2.46.020 to the Coronado Municipal Code (CMC) currently limits the members of the Design Review Commission (DRC) to three professionals in some field of design, one businessperson, and one member with qualifications established by the City Council at its discretion; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Coronado and the public to amend CMC section 2.46.020(C) to increase the potential applicant pool for DRC members while still maintaining a strong preference toward appointing certain professionals likely to have the desired experience and background to serve as effective Commissioners.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Coronado, California, does ordain as follows:

SECTION ONE:

All of the above statements are true and incorporated herein.

SECTION TWO:

Title 2, Chapter 2.46, Section 2.46.020, Paragraph C of the Coronado Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows (underlines are additions and ~~strikeouts~~ are deletions):

C. Three members of the Commission are strongly preferred to ~~shall~~ be professionals in some field of design, including but not limited to architecture, landscaping, interior design, or graphic design. One member is strongly preferred to ~~shall~~ be a businessperson owning, operating, or managing property in the City of a commercial or industrial nature. The qualifications of the remaining member of the commission shall be established by the City Council at its discretion.

SECTION THREE:

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The City Council of the City of Coronado hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion may be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION FOUR:

This Ordinance shall be effective thirty (30) days after its adoption. Within fifteen (15) days after its adoption the City Clerk shall cause this Ordinance to be published pursuant to the provisions of Government Code Section 36933.
