

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-07

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF CORONADO, CALIFORNIA, TO
PROHIBIT RIGHT TURNS ONTO THE BLOCK
153 ALLEY (BETWEEN ORANGE AND D
AVENUES FROM SECOND TO THIRD
STREETS) FROM EASTBOUND SECOND
STREET BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 2:00-
6:00 P.M.**

WHEREAS, City of Coronado Municipal Code Chapter 56.12, Turning Movements, authorizes the prohibition of specific turning movements at intersections between certain hours of any day through the use of signs at such intersections; and

WHEREAS, traffic volume data collected in October 2021 along the Block 153 alley identified increases in traffic volume during specific hours of the day indicative of commuter “cut-through” traffic within the alley inconsistent with an alleys intended use for access to adjacent properties; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coronado Traffic Operations Committee, at its November 18, 2021 meeting, recommended by a 5-0 vote the City Council prohibit right turns into the Block 153 alley between 2:00 – 6:00 pm;

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Coronado as follows:

1. That the project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the State CEQA Guidelines.
2. That Resolution No. 5838, entitled “A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING TURNING MOVEMENTS AT DESIGNATED STREET INTERSECTIONS IN THE CITY OF CORONADO,” adopted May 15, 1979, and as amended to date, is hereby further amended by adding section K.3. to read as follows:

K. SECOND STREET

- b. No right turn for eastbound traffic onto the Block 153 alleyway from 2-6 p.m., except Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays.

3. That the above recitations are true.
