A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORONADO, CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING THE RECEIPT AND APPROPRIATION OF 2022 BOARD OF STATE AND COMMUNITY CORRECTONS (BSCC) FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,891.64 FOR OFFICER WELLNESS AND MENTAL HEALTH GRANT

WHEREAS, the 2022 Budget Act, (Assembly Bill 178, Chapter 45, Statutes of 2022) allocates \$50 million for city and county law enforcement agencies for the purpose of improving officer wellness and expanding mental health sources; and

WHEREAS, the 2022 Budget Act allocation to the City of Coronado is \$30,891.64; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Coronado as follows:

1. That the City Council approves and authorizes the receipt and appropriation of \$30,891.64 in grant funds provided by the Board of State and Community Corrections (BSCC) funds administered through the State of California Budget Act 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these funds, which must be spent by December 1, 2025, be budgeted for expenditure from the Federal Grants Fund 24021000 in Fiscal Year (FY) 2022-23.
