PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, in 1974, the President of the United States signed an executive order establishing an annual celebration of volunteering; and

WHEREAS, the City of Coronado fully supports the benefit of engaging committed members of the public in service to our City; and

WHEREAS, critical incidents can occur at any time that require resources beyond those that are immediately available and Reserve Police Officers, Senior Volunteers, and Chaplains provide numerous hours of service to the Department and community; and

WHEREAS, Coronado Reserve Police Officers donated 180 hours of service participating in routine patrol shifts answering calls for service and assisted during special events; and

WHEREAS, the Senior Volunteers contributed 4,466 hours of service to conduct vehicle and foot patrols, assist at special events, and respond to emergency call outs; and

WHEREAS, our Chaplains dedicate their time and service, making themselves available 24 hours a day to provide support to members of the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, these dedicated men and women carried out all of these duties to serve their communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, on behalf of the City Council of the City of Coronado, I do hereby recognize and proclaim April 21-27, 2024, as:
