CONSIDERATION OF APPOINTMENT OF ONE NEW MEMBER TO SERVE THE REMAINDER OF A TERM ON THE CULTURAL ARTS COMMISSION

RECOMMENDATION:

Consider for appointment Roberta Korte to serve the remainder of a term to expire December 31, 2025 on the Cultural Arts Commission.

BACKGROUND:

The City of Coronado Administrative Procedure No. 204 and Council policy limits the time an individual may serve on a board, commission, or committee to a maximum of two terms or eight years, whichever is less. City Council Policies No. 6 and No. 23 set forth the process for reappointing eligible incumbents and the competitive process to fill vacancies on City boards, commissions, and committees.

ANALYSIS:

Commissioner Teresa Espaniola was first appointed on March 2, 2021. Ms. Espaniola submitted her resignation effective June 30, 2022. The following individual has submitted an application for consideration:
