DESIGNATION OF VOTING DELEGATE AT THE LEAGUE OF CALIFORNIA CITIES ANNUAL BUSINESS MEETING

RECOMMENDATION:

Appoint Councilmember Mike Donovan as the voting delegate for the League of California Cities Annual Business Meeting on September 20-22, 2023, in Sacramento.

BACKGROUND:

The League of California Cities 2023 Annual Conference will be held in Sacramento from September 20-22, 2023. A crucial component of the conference is the Annual Business Meeting, during which the membership takes action on conference resolutions. These resolutions play a significant role in guiding cities and the League to enhance the quality, responsiveness, and vitality of local government.

The Annual Business Meeting is scheduled for Friday, September 22. As per the League's bylaws, a city's voting delegate must be designated by the City Council. The delegate must be registered to attend the conference, and the voting card cannot be transferred unless it is to a City Council-designated alternate.

ANALYSIS:

The City Council's representative to the League San Diego Division has traditionally served as the voting delegate. Councilmember Mike Donovan is currently the League representative. Councilmember Donovan is attending the 2023 Annual Conference and willing to serve as Coronado's voting delegate.
